IMPORTANT DATES

• All senior photos for the yearbook must be turned in by:

Friday, Jan. 8

Until this date, you may choose to use an outside photographer or default to your Lifetouch ID photo. After this date, we will automatically use your Lifetouch ID photo.

• Senior school photo retakes:

Thursday, Oct. 22

You must contact us if you plan to use these retakes as your senior yearbook photo. Otherwise, your original ID photo will serve as the default for your yearbook picture. E-mail:

Friday, Jan. 15

PHOTO SPECIFICATIONS

Give this sheet to your photographer

1. Senior photos should be:
 - Full-color, semi-gloss for prints
 - No smaller than 1.5 inches wide by 2.25 inches high, and no larger than 2 inches wide by 3 inches high
 - CMYK image type, 300 dpi TIF or JPEGs for electronic submission
 - 3/4 frontal view preferred

Please do not crop too closely around the photo.

2. Face size: 1 inch from the top of the forehead (hairline) to the bottom of the chin. Judge accordingly for high hairlines or bangs.

3. Background should be a plain, solid, consistent color. Avoid “busy” backgrounds, overly stylized lighting, props. Outdoor shots accepted as long as background is subdued and not distracting.

You can turn prints in to the Main office, but we prefer electronic submission of photos. You can burn images to a CD, as long as the CD itself is marked with student's first and last name. Or e-mail files to:

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE

This is the photo you will remember your senior year by, so dress appropriately. Think about what you'd wear to a nice restaurant or to church:

PLEASE AVOID:

- T-shirts with writing
- T-shirts with pictures
- Hooded sweatshirts
- Bulky outdoor jackets
- Low-cut dresses or shirts
- Anything too casual or disheveled

Any photo may be rejected for publication in the senior section because of inappropriate attire.
